The views from one success story to another

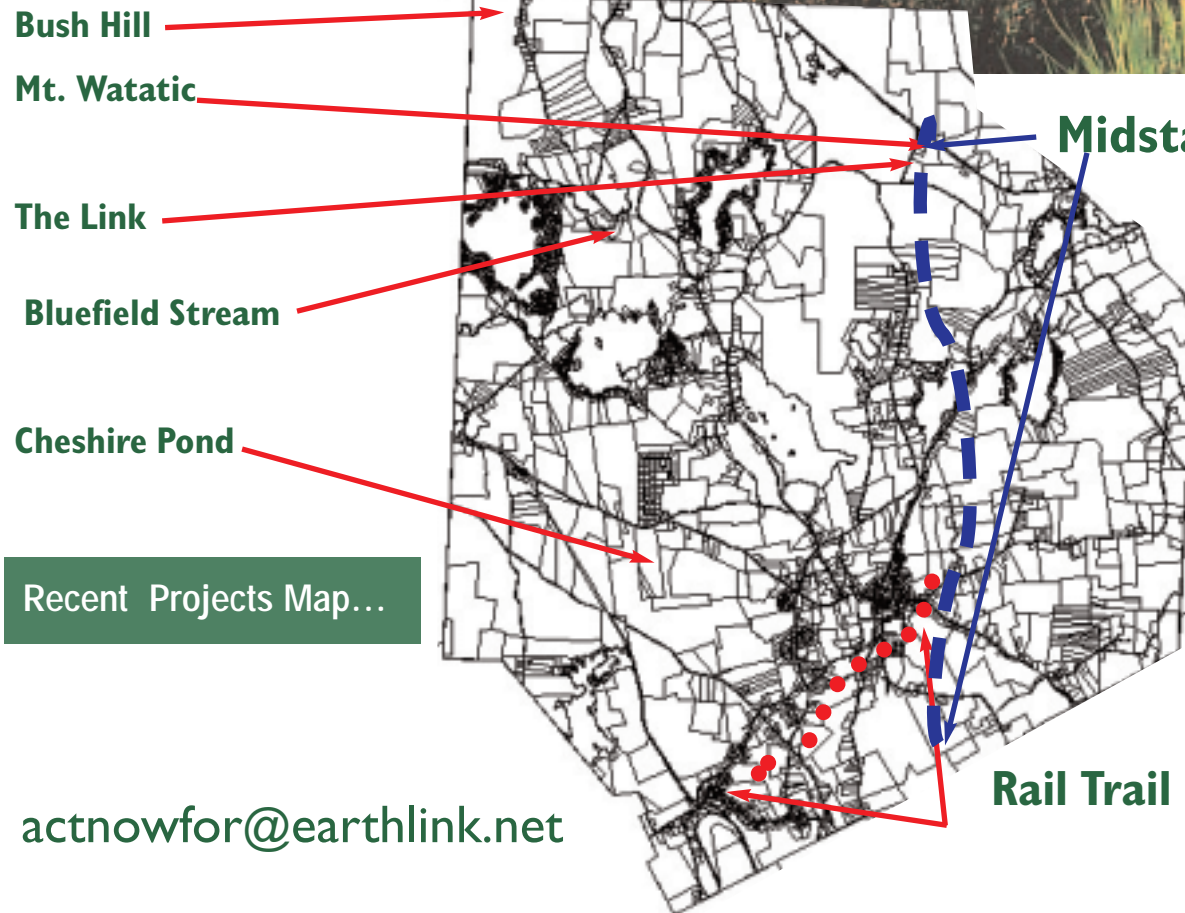
Protected in 2003-2004
